1. CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Annual Town meeting was called to order by Chairman Salvaggio at 7:00 p.m. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance. Seventeen residents were in attendance.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

a. Annual Town Meeting – May 4, 2016

Larry Lechner made a motion to approve the Annual Town Meeting minutes from May 4, 2016. Charles Pretty seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

b. Special Meeting of the Electors – November 30, 2016

Larry Lechner made a motion to approve the Special Meeting of the Electors minutes from November 30, 2016. Charles Pretty seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

3. NEW BUSINESS:

a. Any Other Business Pursuant to *Wisconsin Statutes, Section 60.10*

Larry Lechner made a motion the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg be authorized to exercise the right to purchase real estate for Town public purposes, pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.10(2)(e) including the authority to raise money pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.10(2)(a) or issue general obligation bonds pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.10(2)(d) to finance land purchases. Jerry Zwegers seconded, and the motion passed unanimously with 17 electors voting in favor.

Larry Lechner made a motion the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, as a general and continuing grant, be authorized to exercise the right to purchase any property for Town public purposes, pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.10(2)(e) including the authority to raise money pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.10(2)(a) or issue general obligation bonds pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.10(2)(d) to finance this land purchases. Susan Lechner seconded, and the motion passed unanimously with 17 electors voting in favor.

Larry Lechner then made a motion that the Town of Cedarburg Town Board reject the conditional use permit for the proposed cell tower on the Akerlund property at 4628 Cedar Creek Road. Stacey Cooke seconded, and the motion passed unanimously with 17 electors voting in favor.

4. ADJOURNMENT

At 7:05 pm, Stacey Cooke made a motion to adjourn. Charles Pretty seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
