Town Accepting Applications for \$5,000 Matching Grant for Five Corners Area Businesses

In 2010, the Town of Cedarburg will once again match up to a total of \$5,000 toward exterior improvements to local businesses. Eligible businesses are those that are located along STH 60 between Horns Corners Road and CTH I and those approximately a half mile north and south of STH 60. Applications are available online at www.town.cedarburg.wi.us or at Town Hall and must be submitted by **Friday, May 7th**.

The Town Board created this annual matching grant program in 2007 to support Town businesses. The Five Corners area has long been the heart of the Town's commercial activity. In recognition of the importance of this area, the Town has taken various steps to plan for its development, as illustrated by the Five Corners Master Plan.

Businesses interested in enhancing the appearance of their property are encouraged to create a plan for the proposed improvements and apply for the grant by May 7th. These improvements can be oriented toward the beautification of a building facade or business entrance, including improvements to landscaping, adding/modifying signage or pedestrian lighting, constructing sidewalks, or other such related enhancements.

Past recipients include Cedarburg Auto Park and ATACO Steel, which were awarded grant money in 2007 for signage improvements. In 2008, Five Corners Dodge Chrysler Jeep was awarded \$5,000 for a building façade enhancement. In 2009, the grant was split between three recipients to help defray the cost of various improvements. Cedar Creek Motorsports installed a new ground sign and landscaping, Galioto's Vintage Grille made entrance improvements, and Custom Service Hardware updated the landscaping underneath its existing ground sign and installed three flag poles.
