## Highway 60 & Washington Ave. construction to start August 9th

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is slated to begin construction work on State Highway 60 in the Town of Cedarburg on August 9. Road closures during the project will be limited to one lane at a time. The project involves resurfacing a two-mile stretch of the highway from First Avenue in Grafton west to the Five Corners intersection in the Town and installing traffic signals and turn lanes at the Keup Lane intersection. The project is slated to be completed by the week of October 25. The first phase of the project, which involves the westbound lanes of Highway 60, is expected to be completed by September 13. Work on the eastbound lanes will begin immediately thereafter and continue until the project is finished.

Washington Avenue south of the Five Corners intersection to Sycamore Drive will also be resurfaced. Both Washington Avenue and Highway 60 will remain open to through traffic during the project. One lane in each direction also will remain open on Keup Road.

Access for local properties will be maintained except for the minimum time necessary to complete construction in the immediate vicinity of the property. No driveway approach will be closed or removed from service without prior notice being given to the occupants of the property, allowing them to move their vehicles before the driveway is closed. Access for emergency vehicles to all properties shall be maintained at all times.

Please slow down in the construction zones. Also, please warn your children of the dangers of a construction zone and keep them clear of the area.
