## Bigler Sports Receives Business Development Loan

Bigler Sports, Inc. has been approved for a \$25,000 Business Development Loan by the Town of Cedarburg and Port Washington State Bank (PWSB). The loan, made available through the Town's Business Development Loan program, will finance several interior improvements, including a lounge area for families and spectators, restrooms, and office space, to their facility located at 1275 Hilltop in the Town's Five Corners Business District.

[Bigler Sports](#) offers baseball and softball instruction for a variety of age groups. KJ Bigler issued the following statement, "My relocation experience to Cedarburg has been nothing but positive from the very beginning. The Town has been nothing but supportive throughout the entire process which really helped me to achieve a smooth and timely transition. The loan program offers quick financing at below market rates. It took only eight business days for Bigler Sports, Inc. to apply for and finalize a ten-year loan at a fixed rate of 1%.

The Business Development Loan program, a partnership between the Town and PWSB, was created in October 2013 to assist local businesses. The loan pool established by PWSB is \$250,000; minimum loan amount may not be less than \$5,000 and the maximum loan may not be greater than \$50,000. Eligible loan activities include the acquisition and/or the improvement of land/buildings, facilities and equipment including new construction or renovation, demolition and site preparation.
