Town Board Unanimously Adopts 2015 Budget

No Tax Rate Increase for 8th Year In A Row

On December 3rd, the Cedarburg Town Board approved a \$2.3 million budget that will maintain a high level of service without increasing the tax rate for the eighth consecutive year.

The budget is primarily funded by a property tax levy of \$1,909,415, an increase of \$23,288. The levy increase is directly attributed to the rise in assessed value from new construction. The Town had the largest percent increase in net new construction in Ozaukee County this year. The approved tax rate is \$2.32 per \$1,000 of assessed value. A home assessed for \$300,000 will pay \$697 in property taxes to the Town, which has not changed since 2010.

The 2015 budget funds the annual pavement maintenance program, which will include repaving Horns Corners from Sherman Road south 700 feet and Devonshire Road from Covered Bridge Road to Kingswood Drive. Crackfilling and other road maintenance efforts will receive additional funds in 2015.

The approved budget also funds a new single-stream, curbside recycling program for residential properties. Waste Management will provide this service, which begins on January 5th. Recycling carts are currently scheduled to be delivered beginning on December 15th. A \$42 dollar recycling fee has been placed on the tax bills of improved residential properties to help finance the service for 2015. Tax bills will be delivered as early as next week. The Board also adopted a five-year capital improvement plan that identifies future infrastructure and equipment needs.
