Town Board Awards \$5,000 in Matching Grant Funds to Two Five Corners Area Businesses

At their July 7th regular meeting, the Town Board awarded \$5,000 from the annual Five Corners Matching Grant program to two Five Corners businesses: **Johnson's Gardens & Wayne's Drive-in**. This is the fourth year for the program, which has now granted funds to nine businesses over that span.

Johnson's Gardens, located at 8502 STH 60, was awarded \$3,500 to assist in a \$12,078 facelift to their existing farmhouse, which will accompany landscaping to take place after the exterior updates are complete. Once their renovation project is complete, their entrance will be a unique example of different outdoor living spaces and landscape gardens.

Wayne's Drive-In, located at 1331 Covered Bridge Road (just north of Five Corners), was awarded \$1,500 to assist them with a \$7,470 update to their Neon lighting on the building with energy-efficient LED lighting.

The matching grant is designed to encourage businesses to make improvements that will not only benefit their business, but also enhance the Five Corners area. Eligible businesses are those that are located along STH 60 between Horns Corners Rd. and CTH I and those approximately a half mile north and south of STH 60.
