Nominations Sought for Historic Preservation Award

Nominations due April 1st

The Town of Cedarburg is now accepting nominations for its Preservation Award. The Preservation Award recognizes historic structures in the Town of Cedarburg that have been recently restored or preserved. Nominations may be made by the owners of a historic structure or by friends, relatives or neighbors.

The award was last presented in 2014 to Roger & Fran Bentz for their farmstead, located at 1051 Wauwatosa Road. The Bentz farmstead was purchased by Roger's great-great-grandfather in 1865 upon returning from service in the Civil War. The property includes the home, main barn, smokehouse, and milk house.
