News Release

On Thursday September 2nd 2010 at approximately 10:56am Ozaukee Sheriff's Department deputies responded to a residence on Swallow Drive in the Town of Cedarburg regarding a threatening note. The note left by a suspicious male, appeared to attempt to lure the resident from her house. A 46 year old female resident was home alone at the time. She recognized the male subject who left the note as the same individual who was in the neighborhood acting suspicious approximately one week earlier.

Based on the content of the note the Sheriff's Department conducted a search and canvass of the neighborhood and surrounding area. Several other witnesses reported to have seen the same individual acting suspiciously on the morning of September 2nd and the week prior but did not contact the Sheriff's Department.

It is believed that a witness who has yet to be identified may have been in close proximity of the individual on the morning of September 2nd while riding a bike on a path in the Swallow Drive subdivision. The Sheriff's Department is reaching out to that individual or anyone else who may have information concerning the identity of the suspicious person described below.

The suspect is described as follows:

- Male
- 5'10" to 6' Tall
- Slender Build
- Clean shaven
- Dark hair

The suspect has dressed unusually and may be attempting to conceal his identity or blend in as a worker. He has been seen on a bicycle and his

dress would not be consistent with someone riding a bicycle, especially during hot weather. He has also spent an unusual amount of time lingering around the victim's residence.

Anyone who may have seen this individual and has not been in contact with investigators is asked to call the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Department.

In addition to the above the Sheriff's Department is aware of the community's concern and would like the citizen to understand the following.

- The Sheriff's Department has and will continue to have an increased presence in the area
- The Sheriff's Department Detective Bureau is treating this investigation as a high priority
- Speculation concerning the suspects motive in this case would be counterproductive
- Citizens should be diligent in watching for and reporting suspicious person(s), vehicle or activity
