Last year, the Preservation Award was given to Roger & Fran Bentz for their farmstead, located at 1051 Wauwatosa Road. The Bentz farmstead was purchased by Roger's great-great-grandfather in 1865 upon returning from service in the Civil War. The property includes the home, main barn, smokehouse, and milk house.
