Town Offers Resident-friendly Payment Options *Increase Efficiency & Improves Service*

The Town of Cedarburg has partnered with GovPayNet to accept major credit and debit card brands for payments twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week [online](#) or by phone at 1-888-604-7888. Credit and debit card payments will also be accepted at Town Hall during business hours.

Payments accepted [online](#) and over the phone with GovPayNet include all Town invoiced items (i.e. brush collection & special pick-ups) and refuse carts. Payments accepted at Town Hall include all Town invoiced items, refuse carts, dog licenses, building permits, recreation registration fees, operator licenses, etc.

Not only are these new payment options resident-friendly, but they also increase the efficiency and improve the service provided by the Town.

GovPayNet accepts MasterCard®, Visa®, American Express® and Discover®. For added convenience, GovPayNet has a fully staffed, bilingual call center available 24/7 to accept payments and address all cardholder inquiries/issues. Cardholders pay a service fee at the time of their transaction. In keeping with the Town's user pays approach, there are no charges to the Town for participation in the GovPayNet service.

GovPayNet, based in Indianapolis, is a leader in accepting credit and debit card payments, on behalf of consumers, to government agencies. More than 1,400 agencies in over 40 states rely on GovPayNet to process payments from nearly a million consumers annually.
