Town Celebrates Wisconsin Historic Preservation Month with Cedarburg Cultural Center Partnership

Through a generous donation to the Town of Cedarburg, a new collection of photographs and other materials that chronicle Cedarburg history will soon be made available to the public by the Cedarburg Cultural Center.

Tarq Durante, owner of [Cedarburg Auction Company](#), recently donated dozens of old photographs, newspaper clippings, letters, and other materials to the Town. Much of the collection details life in a part of the Town known as [Hamilton](#), which is recognized on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Town has loaned the Durante collection to the Cedarburg Cultural Center for inclusion in their Cedarburg Heritage Photo Project. Pictures dating as far back as the late 1800s will be scanned by the Cultural Center and made available to the public at no charge. The Cultural Center will also provide the Town digital copies of the photographs. The Town will make the collection available to the Ozaukee County Historical Society.
