Town Authorizes Purchase of Five Corners Area Property

On September 3rd, the Town Board approved the purchase of a 3.65 acre parcel just south of the Five Corners intersection on Washington Avenue. This property (1267 Washington Avenue) will play an important role in the future needs of the Town and could be used to help redevelop the Five Corners area into a vibrant and pedestrian-friendly town center.

“The acquisition of this property is another proactive step toward the redevelopment of Five Corners,” stated Town Chairman Dave Valentine. “This parcel is particularly important because it is adjacent to the Town sports complex property and two other town-owned parcels.”

Five Corners is an ideal area for commercial development because approximately 13,400 cars travel through the intersection each day. The Town has extensively studied the redevelopment of Five Corners over the past several years, culminating in the adoption of the Five Corners Master Plan in April 2006.
