RESOLUTION #2010-6

“A Resolution in Opposition to the Joint Ozaukee Sheboygan Counties’
Library Services Plan – 2011 to 2015”

- WHEREAS,** the Town of Cedarburg is an unincorporated Town within Ozaukee County, Wisconsin;
- WHEREAS,** Ozaukee County has requested the Town of Cedarburg and other municipalities express an opinion on the Joint Ozaukee Sheboygan Counties’ Library Services Plan – 2011 to 2015;
- WHEREAS,** the Town Board welcomed and heard a presentation of the library services plan by the director of the Eastern Shores Library System on February 3, 2010;
- WHEREAS,** the Town Board has carefully reviewed the library services plan and considered additional information, including an analysis by the Eastern Shores Library System on the property tax implications of the proposed plan;
- WHEREAS,** this property tax analysis indicated Town of Cedarburg taxpayers would pay over \$17,400 more for library services if the plan were adopted by Ozaukee County due to the proposed increase in the reimbursement required of non-librarians communities;
- WHEREAS,** the library services plan would raise the reimbursement level to 93%, which is 23% higher than what is required by state statute;
- WHEREAS,** the Town Board can not support this unjustified effort to raise the reimbursement level, especially considering the financial strain our residents are experiencing due to the poor condition of our state and national economy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of Supervisors in Cedarburg, Wisconsin does hereby oppose the Joint Ozaukee Sheboygan Counties’ Library Services Plan – 2011 to 2015.
