RESOLUTION #2013-7

“Accepting a pedestrian bridge as a public amenity in the Pleasant Valley Preserve Subdivision on parcel #030820000001 in the Town of Cedarburg”

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg accepted the document titled “Subdivision Development Agreement Between Town of Cedarburg and Pleasant Valley Preserve, LLC” via Town resolution #2004-6; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the agreement the Town accepted public improvements for the development, one of such being a paved pedestrian walkway/bike path; and


WHEREAS, further, the Developer’s Agreement notes that, “Bicycle and/or walking paths included in this subdivision shall be noted on the final plat as a permanent easement to the Town. The Town will be responsible for all future maintenance of the asphalt bicycle and/or walking paths and associated facilities”; and


WHEREAS, Ozaukee County has proposed for a culvert removal and wooden bridge installation to be constructed by the Ozaukee Fish Passage Program (Ozaukee County Planning & Parks Department) as part of a larger, ongoing program to improve passage of native fish in the Milwaukee River Watershed within the Pleasant Valley Preserve subdivision on parcel #030820000001; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of Ozaukee County to have the Town of Cedarburg accept the bridge as a public improvement, taking on all future maintenance costs once the County has completed initial construction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Wisconsin does hereby accept the aforementioned wooden pedestrian bridge to be constructed on parcel #030820000001 as an associated facility of the paved pedestrian walkway/bike path.
