**RESOLUTION #2014-17**

“A Resolution Opposing Joint Library Planning Committee’s Recommendation to Continue Existing Method of Funding Bookmobile Service in Ozaukee County”

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedarburg appreciates the hard work of the Ozaukee and Sheboygan Joint Library Planning Committee to complete the 2016-2020 Joint Library Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedarburg is considered a non-librariated community and comprises over 30% of the non-librariated population in Ozaukee County; and

**WHEREAS**, Town of Cedarburg residents did not have a chance to vote on whether to continue the Bookmobile service in the 2008 referendum because the Town of Cedarburg was considered a librariated community at that time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedarburg comprises nearly 41% of the equalized value of all the non-librariated communities in Ozaukee County and therefore pays nearly 41% of the cost of Bookmobile service in Ozaukee County; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedarburg receives no service from the Bookmobile and does not desire to receive service from the Bookmobile.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Town Board of Supervisors in Cedarburg Wisconsin does hereby call upon the Joint Library Planning Committee to recommend funding of the Bookmobile by only those communities that receive and desire service or to discontinue Bookmobile Service in Ozaukee County.

This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
