**IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF CEDARBURG, WISCONSIN  
RESOLUTION #2014-20**

**“A Resolution Regarding the United Way”**

**WHEREAS**, Ozaukee County has two United Ways functioning within the county - the United Way of Northern Ozaukee (UWNO) and the United Way of Greater Milwaukee (UWGM); and

**WHEREAS**, the UWGM includes the Town and City of Cedarburg, the Town and Village of Grafton, the Village of Thiensville and the City of Mequon, which consists of approximately 68% of the total county population; and

**WHEREAS**, the UWGM understandably focuses on the critical needs of the City of Milwaukee and allocates only some ½ percent of their budget to Ozaukee County needs and agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the UWGM has no presence in Ozaukee County determining needs or working with County agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, no other county abutting Milwaukee County has their major communities districted with the UWGM; and


**WHEREAS**, a United Way consisting of all Ozaukee County, would be run by Ozaukee County volunteers who understand and work with County communities and agencies as to their needs and performance; and

**WHEREAS**, all the contributions to United Way from Ozaukee County residents would be used to support county agencies, rather than be diluted per currently, where county contributions to the UWGM help support Milwaukee needs;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** The Town of Cedarburg Town Board does thus conclude that they enthusiastically support the creation of a single United Way of Ozaukee County to include the entire county and they call on the United Way America to alter the district boundaries for the 2015 United Way campaign with all deliberate speed.

This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
