

**TOWN OF CEDARBURG
ORDINANCE NO. 2012-17**

**An Ordinance to Amend Section 320-116, Fences and hedges.,
Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin,
relating to barbed wire fences and fence materials.**

- WHEREAS,** The Town of Cedarburg is a body corporate and politic; and
- WHEREAS,** the Town Board exercises village powers by Ch. 61, Wis. Stats.; and
- WHEREAS,** the Plan Commission is in favor of allowing barbed wire fences on industrially zoned properties so long as the barbed wire is at least 8 feet above the ground and projects toward the fenced property and away from any public area and avoids hanging onto adjacent private property; and secondly is in favor of adding plastic and composite as allowable fencing materials; and
- WHEREAS,** the Plan Commission has reviewed this ordinance and has made a favorable recommendation to the Town Board for its adoption; and
- WHEREAS,** the Town Board held a public hearing regarding the proposed amendments, a notice of which was published twice, once at least ten days prior to the date of the hearing,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that Chapter 320 Zoning of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 320-116. Fences and hedges.


- A. Fences defined. For the purpose of this section, "fence" is herein defined as an enclosed barrier consisting of vegetation, plastic, composite, wood, stone or metal intended to prevent ingress or egress. For the purpose of this section, the term "fence" shall include plantings, such as hedges and shrubbery. No fence shall be constructed of unsightly or dangerous materials that would constitute a nuisance.
- E. Prohibited fences. No residential fence shall be constructed which is a dangerous condition, or which conducts electricity or is designed to electrically shock, or which uses barbed wire; provided, however, that barbed wire may be used in industrially zoned areas if the devices securing the barbed wire to the fence are ~~at least 8 feet above the ground or in height and project toward the fenced property and away from any public area~~ and do not hang onto adjacent private property.
