

**TOWN OF CEDARBURG
ORDINANCE NO. 2012-19**

An Ordinance amending Section 305-8, reducing the speed limit on a section of Green Bay Road.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg has legal authority by Wisconsin State Statute 349.11(3)(c) to reduce statutory speed limits on Town roads; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed a traffic study of this area and believes it to be in the best interest of the Town to reduce the speed limit on a section of Green Bay Road as specified below; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes reducing the specified speed limit will protect the health, safety and welfare of Town Residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that the following section of Chapter 305, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances are hereby amended to read as follows:

§305-8. Speed Limits

B. Speed limits increased or established. The speed limits are increased or established as hereinafter set forth in this subsection upon the following streets or portions thereof between the limits designated:

(3) A speed limit of 25 miles per hour on the following highways:


Name of Street	Location
Green Bay Road	From Pioneer Road (County Trunk Highway C) to the <u>Town of Grafton corporate limits</u>

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
