RESOLUTION #2013-15

“Resolution Changing the Number of Poll Workers”


WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg is a body corporate and politic within Ozaukee County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Per Section 7.32, Wis. Stats., allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from [7 or 5 (in a municipality where voting machines are used)] to no less than 3, and the Town Board has determined that it would be advantageous to the Town to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.


WHEREAS, the Town desires to employ a number of poll workers sufficient to provide convenient ballot casting in elections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, declares there shall be a minimum of 5 election officials on duty at each Town polling location at every election. At the discretion of the town clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at any Town polling location at any given election shall always be an odd number.
